

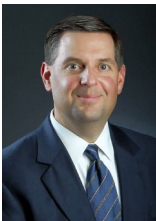
PA Attorney General Candidates

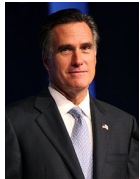
Presidential Candidates

Democrat: Barack Obama



- Currently 44th President of the United States
- Graduate of Columbia University and Harvard University
- U.S. (2005-2008) and Illinois (1997-2004) Senator
- Recipient of Noble Peace Prize
- As President, signed American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, and Don't Ask, Don't Tell Repeal Act

Republican: Mitt Romney



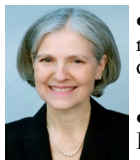
- 70th Governor of Massachusetts (2003-2007)
- Graduate of Brigham Young and Harvard University
- Manager of the 2002 Salt Lake City Winter Olympics
- Co-founder and CEO of Bain Capital (1984-2002)
- During his time in office, MA unemployment decreased from 5.6 % to 4.7%

Libertarian: Gary Johnson



- 29th Governor of New Mexico (1995-2003)
- Vetoed over 750 bills, cut taxes 14 times, and left NM with a balanced budget (one of only 4 states)
- Founder of Our America Initiative, advocating "fiscal responsibility, civil liberties, and rational public policy"

Green: Dr. Jill Stein



- Mother, physician, teacher of internal medicine, and environmental health advocate
- Graduate of Harvard University and Harvard Medical School
- Co-author of various widely-praised environmental health reports

U.S. State Senator Candidates

Democrat: Bob Casey, Jr.



- Currently United States Senator from PA
- Graduate of The Catholic University of America
- Expanded Child Tax Credit and the reduction in the EITC marriage penalty that helped working families and children
- Strong supporter of extending unemployment insurance benefits

Republican: Tom Smith



- Involved in local politics as a Democrat, serving on the Plumcreek Township Board of Supervisors as President of the Board (1975)
- Democratic committeeman as recently as 2010
- Determined to energize our future— American Energy for American Jobs
- Seeks to repeal and replace Obama Care
- Focuses on instituting a flat tax and closing special interest loopholes

Libertarian: Rayburn Douglas Smith

- Determined to end welfare
- Focuses on deregulating the healthcare industry
